Buildings, Electrical and Mechanical Works –
Outreach Vaccination Service for Construction Sites in Kai Tak

The Government's outreach COVID-19 vaccination service was available to the site workers of the Central Kowloon Route and the Kai Tak Development Area on 27 and 28 May 2021. Vaccination service teams currently operating Community Vaccination Centres visited the Central Kowloon Route – Buildings, Electrical and Mechanical Works project site office to provide vaccination service. Around 500 doses had been administered over the two days.
